PRIVACY POLICY

1. About this Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy applies to your access to or use of our website, applications and other services, including activities that refer to or refer to this Privacy Policy (to interfaces) activities referred to as "Services".

We may provide you with other privacy notices, terms or notices that supplement this Privacy Policy. SICC owns or manages the Services described herein and is the primary controller of your personal information provided to, collected by, or for the Services.

2. Information we collect

2.3 Data from other sources

We may also obtain your contact details and other information about you from other third parties, including:

2.3.3 Businesses with which we partner to provide co-branded services or participate in co-marketing activities;

2.4 Data generated when using the "Services", including cookiesThe Service may automatically collect information about how you and your device interact with the Service, including:

2.4.1 Computer, device and connection information, such as IP address, browser type and version, operating system and other software installed on your device, mobile platform and device unique identifiers, and other technical identifiers, bug reports and performance data;

2.4.2 Usage data, such as the features you use, the settings you choose, your URL clickstream data, including date and time stamps of referring and exit pages, the search terms you use, and the information you visit or search for on the Service page;

2.4.3 For location-aware "services," the region where your device is located in order to provide you with content more relevant to your location.

We collect this data through our servers and the use of cookies and other technologies. A cookie is a small text file placed on your hard drive by a web server at your domain and can be read by that server. We may use cookies and other technologies to store your preferences and settings, help you log in, serve targeted advertising, and analyze site operations. You can control cookies through your browser settings and other tools. However, if you block certain cookies, you may not be able to register, log in, or access certain parts of the

Service or fully use the Service. For more details, please see the Service's Cookie Policy.

3. How we use your information

Depending on how you interact with us and the Services, we will use your personal information to:

3.1 Provide, activate and manage your access to and use of the Services;

3.2 Process and fulfill requests, orders, downloads, subscriptions or other transactions;

3.3 Provide technical, product and other support to help keep the Service up, safe and stable;

3.4 To enhance and improve the Service and our other products, activities and services, and to develop new products, services and benefits;

3.5 Provide you with customized content and other personalization settings to make the Services more relevant to your interests and location;

3.6 Respond to your requests, inquiries, comments and concerns;

3.7 Notify you of changes, updates and other announcements related to the Services and our other products and services;

3.8 To comply with our legal obligations, resolve disputes and enforce our agreements.

4. Basis for processing information

When we collect or otherwise process any personal information within the framework of applicable data protection laws, our purposes are:
